Course presentation	The course in Contemporary History – Workshop on Source Analysis aims to provide students with a basic knowledge of historical research methodology, also offering them interpretative tools for some key periods of contemporary reality (20th century). The course will be divided into lessons dedicated to the examination of some of the most significant aspects relating to the period indicated, including the study of sources useful in historical research, historiographic interpretations, reconstruction methodology.
