Aeffective specializes in sentiment analysis and emotion recognition software. Her theoretical interests focus primarily on the category of "Time," with particular attention to the temporal processes of vital experience and phenomena in general. On the application level, she deals with the relationship between qualitative experience and linguistic expression, focusing on ontology and its modeling. Letizia has published academic articles and has participated in several international conferences. Her current research project is centered on pain, highlighting her profile that integrates both pure theory and practical application.
